toru yamanaka [to-ro-ya-ma-na-ka] n. a computer musician who is the main collaborator of teiji / dumb type productions.

yen [y-en] n. a pop vocalist who has experimented with unconventional ways of voice production; (combined commercial music production and avant garde singing heavily inspired by middle eastern / moorish music).

yoshiide otomo [yo-shi-i-de-o-to-mo] n. a turntablist / dj who experiments with the turntable as a sound instrument; of late, much of his work has concentrated in experimental concerts in europe where he collaborates with other sound artists from the continent.

Established in 1994 by Ong Keng Sen, Artistic Director of TheatreWorks Singapore, the Flying Circus Project is a major program exploring Asian traditional arts for the 21st Century. This multi-disciplinary, long-term research and development program in theatre, dance, music, visual arts, film and visual has continued for six years, with laboratories consisting of classes, improvisation workshops and seminars.

The focal point is on cultural negotiation and process in the arts practice. It looks at the different creative strategies of individual artists, both traditional and contemporary, through the recognition of differences between the many Asian cultures. The development of artists in external form, internal landscape, intellectual masculinity and politicization are major pillars of the FCP.

This third phase in year 2000 involves artists from China, Taiwan, Philippines, Japan/Korea, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore. The theme for this lab is Asian religious ritual and its interface with the urban artist from contemporary Asia.
