Wilson Wong's play "Green Socks" won the 1988 Shell/NUS Short Play Competition. "Green Socks" premieres at the Drama Festival Fringe this August and will open in April 1990 (as an extended play) as TheatreWorks' closing production for the 1989/90 season.

"Green Socks" is a black comedy which opens with a woman mourning the loss of her TV set. The dead TV sits on a table draped with white cloth. A solemn wreath and white candles complete the spectacle. In the midst of her tears and loud wails, her dead son returns...alive.
