Actually, I think a "happening" just about covers it.

The Malaysian FIVE ARTS troupe, led by the incredible Marion D'Cruz, are coming with a never-before-in-Singapore repertoire.

You start in the Park with performers in pots. Face the Fort for a dance in glass. Stroll to Studio One for an enlightening immersion in Chinese family altars. Jog along to the Black Box to witness the last seven hours in the life of a not-pretty prostitute (in dance and English-Bahasa). Then you just sight tight and have a good laugh.

That's the first five items.

After the Intermission (!) you'll be ushered in to the Gallery where a magnificent picture by Wong Hoy Cheong is both the centrepiece and the inspiration for a multi-media performance. You'll see the combined effects of dance, voice, video, visual art and rhythm.

That's it.

An unconventional mix of six dynamic disciplines which defy and also marry the freeform categories of performance art.

If that sounds like I'm over-intellectualising -- and I think it does! -- then I apologise. But I for one will be fascinated by the lecture that FIVE ARTS is bringing.


