Winner of the 24-Hour Playwriting Competition 2010 (Open Category), this one-woman play stirs to life the voice of Safiah like a perfect dish of serunding. A Malay homemaker, Safiah's belief as a devout Muslim and parental expectations fall into conflict with her children; and suffers tedious ties with her mother-in-law 'Sofes Jane'. Told through humour, food and many phone calls, Serunding draws us to the heart and pain of a mother's love. A spicy sweet expression of the Singapore family caught at the centre of cultural values and modern living. Performed in English.

The Writers' Laboratory is the longest running developmental programme for playwrights in Singapore. 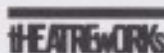
