Singapore Young Dramatist Awards 2000 / 2001

Rules & Regulations

- 01. The 2000 Singapore Young Dramatist Awards is opened to all Singapore students who falls under the two categories, age as of Jan 2000.
- 02. Entries must be original and must not have been previously performed, published or read publicly.
- 03. Co-authored or single author works which have previously won awards either in Singapore or overseas competition will not be accepted.
- 04. Entries should not be concurrently submitted for other competitions, publications or for broadcast until the announcement or broadcast of the results of the Singapore Young Dramatist Awards.
- 05. Entrants may write on any subject or theme.
- 06. The minimum length of entry is not less than 8,000 words.
- 07. Entrants may submit a maximum of 7 copies, typed or written.
- 08. Judging are based on the quality of writing and performability of writing.
- 09. 4 scripts from each category will be selected first and read in the final round.

- 10. 3 prizes will be awarded for each category at the finals.
- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the finals.
- 12. The school with the winning entrant will be awarded with a challenge trophy.
- 13. 2 panels of judges will be appointed by the organisers.
- 14. The judges decision is final. No correspondence regarding the judging of entries will be entertained at any time.
- 15. The judges reserve the right not to award any or all of the advertised prizes.
- 16. Entries should be submitted by mail no longer than 8 December 2000 to the following address:
