Singapore Young Dramatist Awards 2000 / 2001

Rules & Regulations

01. The 2000 Singapore Young Dramatist Awards is opened to all Singapore students who falls under the two categories, age as of Jan 2000.
02. Entries must be original and must not have been previously performed, published or read publicly.
03. Co-authored or single author works which have previously won awards either in Singapore or overseas competition will not be accepted.
04. Entries should not be concurrently submitted for other competitions, publications or for broadcast until the announcement or broadcast of the results of the Singapore Young Dramatist Awards.
05. Entrants may write on any subject or theme.
06. The minimum length of entry is not less than 8,000 words.
07. Entrants may submit a maximum of 7 copies, typed or written.
08. Judging are based on the quality of writing and performability of writing.
09. 4 scripts from each category will be selected first and read in the final round.
10. 3 prizes will be awarded for each category at the finals.
11. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the finals.
12. The school with the winning entrant will be awarded with a challenge trophy.
13. 2 panels of judges will be appointed by the organisers.
14. The judges decision is final. No correspondence regarding the judging of entries will be entertained at any time.
15. The judges reserve the right not to award any or all of the advertised prizes.
16. Entries should be submitted by mail no longer than **8 December 2000** to the following address:
