RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 3) The 24 Hour Psywiting Competition is open to all Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents (residents in Singapore for at least a year), except fall-time employees of ThestreWorks (5) Ltd. Winners of past years' 24-Hour Psywiting Competition may not apply.
- 02 There are two categories opened to appring playwrights: Youth (13-18 years) and Open (19 years and above), ask as at 1 January 2005, Planes limited to 100.
- 03 The closing date for submission of registration form is 1 July 2005.
- O4. All registration forms must be accompanied by payment of registration fees to be made by chapue, money order or postal order, payable to TheathyWorks (Engagery) Limited Participation is confirmed only upon recept of full payment.
- 55 The regeleration fee is inclusive of food and beverages during the competition and a sunskill kit, and is strictly non-refundable and non-transferable under any discurrentations.
- (b) Participants will be required to work within the competition venue from 4 pm on 16 July 2005 to 4 pm on 17 July 2005. They will not be allowed to leave the designated promises. Any departure without prior notice or permission from the originaters, will result in intermediate designations.
- Q7. Perfolipants will be required to complete at least a short play (technion 12 to 35 single-spaced pages) using English as the main language medium. They may use other languages in their pieces but it should be kept to a minimum with stranslations provided focusions.
- (b) Participhets will be given creative stimul at regular intervals within the 2-thing period. These stimule will be in the form of objects, places, unatures of delegate phrases or actions, which the participants must incorporate into their script. The stimule must be utilised in its original form (eg. no change of tense, no exchapabilities, etc). The stimule will be delivered to the participants a workfall time.

- Participants should note that the created inagration or the tomas will be the main consideration in the judging of their works. Should they omit any of the stimul, their scripts will be penalised accordingly.
- (9) Hand-written or type-written scripts are acceptable. Writing materials like paper and pens would be available, though participants are strongly encouraged to bring their own leptops and favourite stationeries. The organisers will also be providing printing and photocopying facilities.
- 10 Discussion among the participants during the competition is strictly discouraged.
- A complete script must be submitted to the organizers by 4 pm on 17 July 2005.
 No late submissions will be entertained. Participants who fall to complete a script
