#### Rules and Regulations

- The 24-Hour Playwriting Competition 2009 is open to all Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents tresidents in Singapore for at least a year) except full-time employees, officers and representatives of the organiser and sponsors as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, stolings and children) and household members of each such employee.
- There are two colegaries opened to aspiring playwights. Youth (15-18 years) and Open (19 years) and abovel age as at 1 January 2009. Places limited to \$0.
- 3. Parliaipants will be required to work within the competition venue from 4 pm on 19 July 2009 to 4 pm on 19 July 2009. They will not be allowed to leave the designated premises. Any departure without prior notice or permission from the organiser, will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants will be required to complete at least a short play (between 12 to 30 single-spaced pages) in the English language. They may use other languages but it should be kept to a minimum with translations provided / footnoted.
- 5. Participants will be given creative stimuli at regular intervals within the 24-hour period These stimuli will be in the form of objects, places, snatches of dialogue, phrases or actions, which the participants must incorporate into their scripts. The stimuli must be utilised in its original form leg no change of tense no entropolation etc. The stimuli will be delivered to the participants of specified times. Participants should note that the creative integration of the stimuli will be the mightimes. Participants should not their warks. Should they and any of the stimuli, their scripts will be penalised accordingly.
- 6. Discussion among the participants during the competition is strictly discouraged.
- A complete script must be submitted to the organiser by 4 pm on 19 July 2003. No late submissions
  will be entertained. Participants who fail to submit on time or who submit on incomplete script will
  also be disqualified.
- Entires should not be concurrently submitted for other competitions, publications or broadcast until the announcement or broadcast of the results of the 29-Hour Poyunting Competition.
- 9. Winners will be notified by post no later than October 2009. The judges' decision is final. The judges reserve the right not to award any or oil of the obvertised prizes. No correspondence regarding the judging of the entries will be entertained at any time.
- 10. The winning scripts stand to be developed in the GREEN IOUSE as a performance-ready script.
- 11. The organiser and spansors without be responsible for any injuries, deaths, accidents linesses or other loss or damage suffered by the participants owing the course of the competition. All participants are required to sign on indemnity formation to the competition.

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
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
