

It seems like such an easy and maybe even lazy thing to say, that I want to promote the idea of enjoyment within a work process. It also sounds a bit un-elegant, this seriousness about enjoyment. But I think it is ok. For


me, it is perfectly alright, if the whole enterprise is just "to have a good time, to spend time together, to enjoy each other's company."

So, for 11 weeks the three of us formed a micro-society here in our new playground, 72-13. We had many discussions, trying to sell our ideas to each other. We spent our time pitching, evaluating, developing, and accepting or rejecting ideas. When we disagreed with each other, we found ways to communicate. There was a real (for me almost desperate) search for answers about the artwork, and at the same time, humor and enjoyment. This is just as important to me, as the actual performance.

As for the performance itself, we are showcasing performance ideas that have been accepted, or, more accurately, not rejected, by the members of our micro-society. In some ways, it is an exercise in composition, trying to arrange these independentlyexisting ideas into a sequence that makes sense, that in the end, causes the ideas to become co-dependent on each other and the very sequence that they are built into.

As the composition was born, I tried to understand what the performance was all about. I have some conclusions, but it is probably better not to say them, and let the audience have the fun of looking - or not looking - for their own.
